#### The Self-Assessment Explained & What You Can Expect

- Expect to see and experience the promises of God's word as you renew your mind in His wisdom, become LOVE in the world just like Jesus, and begin understanding and living the lifestyle you were created to live, the Gospel Rich Lifestyle.
- This self-assessment is designed to help you explore, discover, and develop yourself based on God's standards for LOVE as written in 1 Corinthians 13. As Christians, we are on a daily journey to seek God's wisdom and grow in our faith. This activity can help guide your way to becoming more integrated in God's word and specifically becoming the LOVE of Christ personified in the world.
- As you get started, if you realize you have not demonstrated all of God's standards for LOVE in the fullest it's OK. Never worry about this and just know growth is ongoing and lifelong. Stay committed to the process and you will get there. Always be honest in your self-reflection and when using the rating scale. The rating scale is a measure of how you demonstrate each LOVE indicator today. **Get excited about experiencing personal growth as you become more integrated in LOVE as God created us to be.**
- It is recommended that you do this activity periodically to continue growth and reassess. You can do this activity as often as you like once a week or once a month. This activity is great to do independently, as a family, or in a group. This tool is a printable PDF.
